**16** families purchased their forever home, opening the door to stability and self-reliance

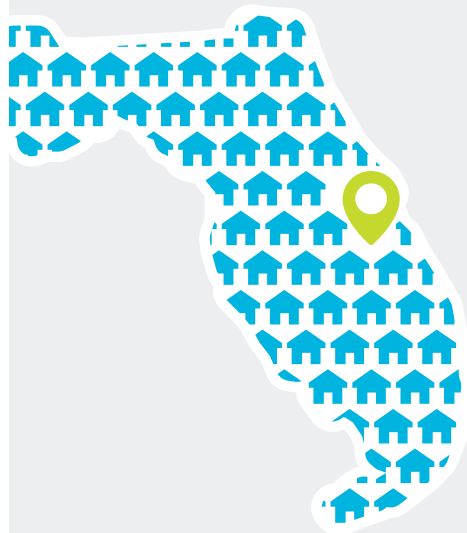
**466** families participated in our Financial Academy and took their first step towards financial freedom

Grew our financial-education program and increased community outreach, achieving record-levels of community participation.

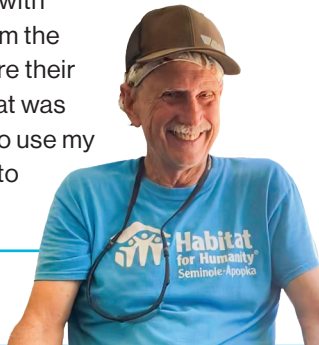


Facilitated new and unique, public-private partnerships that generate self-perpetuating funds and longer-term solutions to our local affordable housing crisis.
